At the site you will be asked to choose a seat in a fictional 900 seat event called

<u>'Act1 Theatre Membership 2024'.</u> <u>The seat you choose will be your membership number</u> and nothing more. It does not entitle you to a specific seat allocation when booking show tickets.</u>

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Fully Paid up Members receive a **Membership Number** to be put in the provided space when making a booking for a show to secure your ticket at Membership Discount price.

<u>Remember</u>, you can only use your number for your own ticket. Full price must be paid for non-members. Payment may be demanded on arrival at the theatre if a membership number has been misused.

Membership Information

Membership renewals for 2024 are due from the 1st January. Membership is <u>\$20 (Full rate);</u> <u>\$15 (Concession cardholders)</u>. **Go to the Trybooking link in the box above.** If unable to use this, alternatives are:

<u>Option A</u>: If there is no-one who can assist you (i.e. family or friend) to follow the procedure, contact Andrew on 0413759741 and have a debit/credit card handy and he will walk you through the process.

<u>Option B</u>: You can renew your membership at the theatre when you come to see the first show of the year. You can purchase tickets to the first show at membership rate using your

The Rules of Act 1 Theatre Incorporated

Act 1 is an Incorporated Association. It differs from a club. A club may have a Constitution, agreed by its members, governing how the club is run. It does not require approval from any outside body.

As an incorporated association, Act 1 has, instead of a Constitution, a set of Rules approved by the responsible government department – the Office of Fair Trading, Qld. Any change to our Rules decided by the members at a general meeting must be approved by that department.

Our Rules were adopted in 1983 when the Aspley Theatre Company became Act 1 Theatre Inc. They have been amended on three occasions since then. They cover the <u>objects and powers</u> of the association, <u>membership</u> requirements, ongoing <u>management</u> through the Management Committee appointed at the Annual General Meeting, requirements for the AGM and other <u>general meetings</u>, and <u>financial management</u>.

The objects of Act 1 Theatre are:

- 'To stimulate public interest and to promote public education in the drama and encourage the study and development of the best in dramatic literature and art';
- 'To produce plays of literary or dramatic merit and educational value'; and
- 'To provide opportunities for training and experience' in theatre.
